

## **Regulations of the charity auction led by the National Museum in Lublin**

### **§ 1**

#### **AUCTION**

1. The organiser of the charity auction is the Homo Faber Association registered in the District Court of Lublin, XI Economic Department of the National Court Register under the number KRS 0000222437, NIP 946 244 29 78, REGON 432738790, hereinafter to be referred to as "Organiser", in cooperation with the National Museum in Lublin, hereinafter to be referred to as "Partner" and the Tamara de Lempicka Estate, hereinafter to be referred to as "Donor".
2. The beneficiary of the Auction is the Homo Faber Association
3. The item of the Auction will be the graphic "Spring" ("Le Printemps"), coloured serigraphy, paper, 148/175, 1996, made in cooperation between Tamara de Lempicka Estate and DK Art Publishing, hereinafter to be referred to as "Graphic", property of the Tamara de Lempicka Estate
4. Whole income of the will be given to conducting the statutory activity of the Homo Faber Association – for the refugees from Ukraine.

### **§ 2**

#### **RULES OF PARTICIPATION**

1. Participants of the auction participants may be persons who are at least 18 years of age and are fully capable to conduct legal actions, legal persons and organisational units which do not have legal personality, but those who can acquire their rights and incur the obligations, hereinafter referred to as Participants.
2. The auction is open - given prices are public information available throughout the duration of the auction.
3. Unacceptable actions are defined as the ones that hinder, destabilize and prevent the auction. In the case of the aforementioned action, the conductor has the right to eliminate the participant from a further auction.

### **§ 3**

#### **COURSE OF THE AUCTION**

1. The item of the auction can be viewed at the time exhibition "Tamara Lempicka - a woman on a journey" organised by the National Museum in Lublin in cooperation with Tamara de Lempicka Estate from 18.03.2022 to 14.08.2022.
2. The auction will be carried out in the Partner's social media - fanpage: [www.facebook.com/MuzeumNarodoweW Lublinie](https://www.facebook.com/MuzeumNarodoweW Lublinie) from 18 March 2022 to 30 June 2022.
3. The starting price of PLN 15 295.00 has been determined for the item.
4. The auction will be carried out by persons appointed by a Partner.
5. The price of overbids offered by participants is opened for other participants of the auction.
6. Submission of the offer takes place through the publication of the comment and is tantamount to acceptance of these Regulations.
7. The subsequent declared overbid must be higher than the previous amount of a minimum of PLN 100.
8. The first and each subsequent price offer submitted by the Auction participant is legally binding and can not be withdrawn.

9. The offer submitted in the course of the auction ceases to be binding when another participant of the auction submits a more favourable offer.
10. The auction is won by the participant, who until the conclusion of the auction made the highest offer.
11. It is up to the Participant to ensure that his offers are not made recklessly, mistakenly or without familiarizing and understanding the consequences of submitting the offer in accordance with these Regulations and the provisions of Polish law.
12. The auction closure will take place on 30 June 2022 at 23:59.
13. The Partner informs the participant about submitting the highest offer by adding an answer in the comment.
14. The winner of the auction is obliged to pay a declared amount in the deadline of 15 days from the moment of closing the auction and to give the Organiser and the Partner its contact details on purpose to receive the reception of auctioned item.
15. In the absence of a payment or lack of giving data referred to in paragraph 14 during the indicated date (15 days), the participant who submitted the subsequent highest offer is the winner of the auction.
16. Payments should be made directly to the Homo Faber's account - in PLN currency to the account with the number: 93 1940 1076 3069 8598 0000 0000 with the note AUCTION, graphic "Spring".
17. The handover of the item of the auction winner will take place after paying the amount of the auction during the closure event of the exhibition "Tamara Lempicka - a woman on the journey".
18. Any cost related to the presence of the Winner of the Auction during the closure event of the exhibition will lay on his side.
19. If the Winner of the Action will not be able to participate in the closure event, the handover of the Graphic will take place by postal shipment at the cost of the museum.
20. The Organiser reserves the right to amend this Regulation.
